## Keeping the team

One of the main items on the agenda in the next few years is to 'map' Trintellas. We will use the so-called BN (bouwnummer = number of construction) document for this. We are going to try and gather the most important information about the history of the boat, the current state of maintenance, and the history of maintenance that has been done. Committee member Willem de Graaf (maintenance) asked members to fill in this form during the annual members' meeting in Kampen. We have received 38 filled out forms and as a result we can take a big step towards our goal.

## Polluted diesel and safe sailing

The KNRM (Royal Dutch Rescue Team) has towed several Trintellas safely to shore throughout last year. For 80% of the KNRM rescues, engines seem to be the cause. A deeper analysis shows that this more often than not is due to pollution of diesel because of bacteria and little regard to the quality of the fuel. Polluted or poor quality diesel oil is a major safety risk.

Peter van der Waa gave a lecture on these issues during a workshop of the FPC in 2014. The key notes of the lecture are available to members on the website. We would like to draw your attention to it again and if you wish to take measures, winter is a great time to prepare. More on this topic? Trintella Friends' Association technical information No.1
