From a photo recognition book to a friend-book

The Trintella Friends' Association considers 'meeting each other' to be one of the most important things. To make that a little easier we used to have a photo book. A useful tool to help us remember other members via ship name of type. Besides that it offers support recognising faces of members who own these boats.

Since the overview only held about 40% of the member and was not available online, we decided together during the previous annual members' meeting that all members would be put into the database. Also we promised to call it friend-book and put it on the website, so only members can access it.

Individual members can now control their personal information - their profile - themselves. Members will from now on add or change information and can change their photos.

It is up to you to watch and update your profile. Instructions for doing that can be found further down this newsletter, under the header: Tips for using the friend-book.

Tips for using the friend-book

You have to be logged onto the website to be able to see the new Trintella Friends' friendbook.

- Did you forget your login details? Either click on Forgot login on the right of the members' login screen or send an email to webmaster@trintella.org
- Once you have logged on you will find a header called Friend-book in the menu on the top right. If you enter a fellow members' name or the name of their Trintel or Trintella yacht you will be directed to their profile. This will show you photos of the member and their yachts.
- Changing your profile. Go to the header on the right called TVK Community. This will lead you to a header called changing profile which enables you to check, add information or add photos to your personal profile. We have already added information and photos we had of you to your profiles.
- Selecting and uploading photos. Please try to be critical (in regards to sharpness, clarity; e.g. no sunglasses) when choosing your photos. Photos that are too large in

size will automatically be cropped. Always check the result of your photos after uploading.

During our research for the Trintella Yachts book we came across very interesting profile drawings of the Trintella Ia, III and the IIIa in the city archive of Den Bosch. The drawer has, so far, remained unknown.

It inspired our chairman, Loet Geldhoff, to edit and digitalise them so they can be published. He has also drawn profile drawings of other models; starting with the classics: the Trintel I and II series and the Trintella I and II series. These were shown during the spring meeting.

So far he has continued and completed the profile drawings of the Trintella 38 and the 42 and is now working on the 44 and 49a. The goal is to eventually have profile drawings of all models.
