

This year's anniversary will be celebrated on Saturday November 17<sup>th</sup>, during our Fall Reunion in 's Hertogenbosch. We will be guests at WSV Viking at the Ertveldplas, the association harbour where Anne Wever was warden, a stone's throw away from the former Trintella shipyard. While the Spring Meeting in Veere was festive already, this Fall Reunion will be a proper anniversary party!

The board has worked very hard to ensure an extra festive programme.



The programme for that Saturday will be as follows:

At 10.00 we welcome you in the WSV Viking clubhouse, with coffee, tea and a Bossche Bol, the pastry 's Hertogenbosch is famous for.

Between 10.30 and 11.00 we will leave for the former Trintella shipyard (see picture), for an interesting and elaborate cruise in the waters in and around 's Hertogenbosch, with the Jeronimus Bosch and the Oude Dirk.

Around 12.30 we will have lunch aboard the excursion boat and, if the weather will allow it so, we will be dropped off in the inner city at 14.00. There will be the opportunity to stretch the legs, shop or get a drink.

At exactly 16.00 we leave for the final part of the cruise.

We dock around 17.00 at the Ertveldplas, where an aperitif will await us in the WSV Viking clubhouse.

There will be a short General Meeting of Members at 18.00, during which our chairman Loet Geldhoff will pass on the gavel to his prospective successor Helms van der Vegte. After this we will welcome some old employees of the shipyard and dinner will commence. Dinner will end around 21.30, and we will conclude the day at 22.00.



The costs for participation are € 65 perperson over 13 years of age. Participants under 13 will be paid for by the TVK.

For the participants that would like to spend the night, we have the option of one of the 24 rooms in hotel De Soete Moeder, for €86 per night, and with 50% off on breakfast. This hotel is built in an old monastery, and is close De Viking. The hotel has a great kitchen and a pleasant restaurant for a lovely dinner. 
#### Ostrea Rose Classic Race 2018




Picture: the Windveer with crew in the harbour
