# Workshop for owners of Classics - useful once again

This previous Saturday 7 March the second Classics workshop took place, in which owners and experts could share their knowledge and experiences about maintenance and technique, about improving comfort and about sailing techniques.



The virus was yet unbeknownst to us, so around 20 participants and supervisors gathered in the new boathouse of WSV Viking at the Ertveldplas in 's-Hertogenbosch (NL).

Divided in types per group (the Trintels, the Trintella I series, and the Trintella II series), they joined in lively debates, and examples, pictures and drawings were shared, regarding subjects specific to the types.

Some of the subjects, such as attrition to rudder hangings with Trintels, was discussed so thoroughly that we can create Technical Information Bulletins based on these conclusions.

These will be added to the column Preservation and Technique on our website, so all owners can use it to their advantage.

It is also important to note that we are creating a WhatsApp group chat per type, so information regarding maintenance and technique, comfort and sailing techniques can be requested and provided easily and directly.
